

Environmental Safety Addendum for EPA registered product

EnviroCon (EPA Reg # 9804-3) is the only EPA registered product under the FIFRA classification for pesticides that Air-Care purchases, stocks and ships. This product is not used in agricultural applications, but is a microbiocide product documented by EPA for use in HVAC systems. EnviroCon has a 2 page document with specific instructions and cautions for the use of this product in HVAC systems and specifically air ducts. This document and the MSDS sheet are shipped with every case of EnviroCon.

Air-Care will follow OSHA MSDS procedures and guidelines for safe use of all chemical products as described in the attached document. Since EnviroCon is registered by EPA, Air-Care will address it specifically in its procedures as described in this addendum.

The Air-Care safety officer, currently Wayne Tracy, Operations Manager, is the designated coordinator for EnviroCon within the workplace and shipments to Air-Care customers. A backup officer will also be designated to perform the required tasks when the Safety Officer is unavailable; this currently is Slavko Lazic, the IT Manager.

Once annually, in January, the Safety Officer will contact Bio-Cide International to download the latest MSDS information and any related documents and request any EPA activity regarding this product such as Label changes regarding the use of this product in HVAC applications. A search of the www.EPA.gov site for "EnviroCon" will also be performed annually and new activity will be reviewed and implemented as required.

The latest EnviroCon MSDS information and application and cautionary documents will be kept on file in PDF form on an Air-Care server so it can be accessed for printing, faxing or emailing to any customer requiring it and for all Air-Care employees that may handle it when shipments arrive or when it is shipped out. The most recent MSDS is dated March 2011. The Air-Care website will also have the latest MSDS information posted for EnviroCon.

The information regarding the safe handling of EnviroCon in its application, accidental spills, clean up of spills and disposal of empty containers will be presented Annually in one of Air-Care's Safety Training meetings for all Employees. This information will also be published annually in one issue of Air-Care's email News letters to all active customers.

Air-Care will print copies of the MSDS sheets and include it in all shipments of EnviroCon to its customers.
